Tournament Rules

- All active duty, active reserve, and full time employees of the Coast Guard, Auxiliary, and their immediate family, (Son, Daughter, Wife or Husband) Inactive reserves are eligible as well. Contractors are not eligible to play.**
- Each team must submit a team roster with player name, rank/rate, and unit assigned to. Rosters must have minimum of (8) players with a maximum of (18). Rosters must be submitted to the tournament coordinator **NLT 1 March**. If your team has more than the max 18 players, that is fine. Just list them on your roster. The coordinated needs **"ALL"** names prior to the tournament, which means if you have players that can not participate in the games on Friday but will be there for Saturday's games then he/she needs to be on your original roster which needs to be on record with the coordinator and Teamworks. If he/she is not on your original roster and you have a player show up after the tournament has started than that person will not allowed to compete in the tournament unless it has been approved by the coordinator of the tournament.
- Players may only play for one team.
- Mouth and eye protection are not mandatory, but are highly Recommended.**
- No checking. Infractions will not be tolerated.
- Referee calls are final. Unsportsmanlike behavior from players and coaches will not be tolerated. Any major un-sportsmanship such as fighting will carry a mandatory **Player withdrawal** and or **Team withdrawal**.
- While game is in play, any player (s) leaving the bench area during any unsportsmanlike altercations will be ejected from that game. If that player (s) receives another major penalty in any other game than he/she is ejected for all remaining games.
- Underage drinking at the tournament receptions will not be tolerated. It is the responsibility of each player to observe and adhere to the drinking age. Violations of this may result in dismissal from the tournament.

Equipment

Mouthpieces, eye protection, shin guards are highly recommended. Wooden sticks are **not** allowed. However, if your stick has a fiberglass wrap around the blade it is allowed. Please no **BLACK** tape. Each team is required to provide goalie gear for there team. Each team should bring a white shirt or black shirt in case both teams have the same colored jerseys. The home team makes the final call concerning jersey.

Games (subject to change)

Each team is guaranteed (3) games. Tournament consists of, (3) 12 minute running time periods, with a 5 minute running time overtime period if needed. If the overtime period is still tied a shoot out will determine the victor. Winning team is awarded **5 points** for a win. **1 point** will be awarded to a team that loses in a tie of regulation play but losses in a shoot out. **(0) Points** will be awarded to a losing team. **1 point** will also be earned to the winning team for each goal scored with the maximum of **5 points**. So a winning team could earn a total of **10 points** per game.

If two or more teams have the same amount of points, then head to head record if played determines the seeding for playoff. If no head to head game was played then the win loss record will be used first, if still tied then goals for will be used second to determine seeding for each team(s), if still tied then goals against will determine playoff seeding, if still tied than the team with less penalty minutes will be used, if still tied than a coin flip will determine seeding.

Four teams will go into the playoffs (**Subject to change**) and is based on a twelve team format. Playoff games will be played using (3) twelve minute periods (2) twelve minute running time periods and (1) twelve minute stop time period. No shootout will be used in the championship game.

(3rd Period playoffs format of (1) twelve minute stop time is subject to change if time appears to be a factor), and team Captains will notified of this prior to the start of the game

A roster **MUST** be submitted prior to the drop of the ball before each game your team plays. Team Coaches, Captains or assistant Captains must submit the roster.

The roster must include name, number and position he/she is slated to play.

Each team can only dress a maximum of 18 players per game. For those teams that have more than 18 players, you will be allowed to have those extra players. However, they can not be on the bench unless they are acting in a coaching role, and if so they can not wear a team jersey. They will be allowed to stand on the side of the bench next to the team.

If a team does not submit a roster prior to the drop of the ball in the first period of each game a team plays on Friday, than that team will receive a **(3) point deduction** from the Head Referee, if that team was awarded any points for that game played, or **(-3) point deduction** if no points were awarded for that team(s) game played on Friday.

No points will be deducted after our final games on Friday. However, if your team does not submit a roster prior to any games played on Saturday than your team will receive 1 minute penalty at the start of the first period.

Remaining Funds

Any remaining funds from the tournament will be carried over to help fund next year's tournament. Funds will be entrusted to the Admiral's Cup Tournament Fund.

Stick Time

Those players arriving early Thursday may take advantage of practice time at the rink. However, you need to call RI Indoor Sports at 401-463-5565 to arrange your times (if available).
